 RUNNER UP: HEKTOR
30 KILLS, WITH ARES
 HELP FOR 8.



**MOST
 BLOODTHIRSTY:**
 DURING HIS ARISTEIA
 IN BOOK 11
 - 1 x SPEAR IN HEAD
 (BRAINS PILL)
 - 2 x SPEAR IN CHEST
 - 1 x SPEAR IN ARM
 - 2 x SWORD IN HEAD/NECK
 - 1 x SWORD USED TO
 CUTOFF HEAD AND
 ARMS!
 - 1 x SPEAR IN THE
 SIDE AND CUTS OFF
 HEAD!



SNEAKIEST:
13 KILLS, 1 WOUNDED
11
 KILLED WITH ARROWS
 "AS THE MAN HE KILLED
 DROPPED DEAD, TEUCER
 LIKE A CHILD RUNNING
 FOR SHELTER TO ITS MOTHER,

**MOST  
 USELESS:**  
 BY NO MEANS THE LEAST  
 KILLS, BUT FOR HIS STATION,  
 COMPARATIVELY WITH OTHERS,  
 HE IS PATHETIC -  
 - challenges GREEKS to a duel,  
 then hangs back when  
 MENELAOS takes the challenge  
 - has to BORROW ARMOUR to  
 complete his duel  
 - APHRODITE has to intervene on  
 his behalf to save his life  
 - ONE OUTRIGHT GOOD KILL  
 - WOUNDS 2 (1 IN FOOT!)  
 KILLS 1 WITH ARROW
