

Rounding Prices.

You can use rounding to check calculations mentally (in your head). This skill is useful when shopping. Always check your change, just in case the cashier has made a mistake. You pay £13.68 for shopping with a £20 note and want to check your change. **Round** the £13.68 up to £14. Work out $20 - 14 = 6$. You should get just over £6 change.

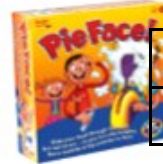
