

## Fungi trump cards

2+ players

- Shuffle and deal all the cards face down.
- Each player holds their cards so they can only see the top one.
- The first player reads out an item and statistic on their top card (eg toxicity 8), the other players then read out their stats for that item.
- The highest value wins and that player adds all the top cards to the bottom of their pile.
- The winning player then picks a category from their next card and play starts again.
- If two or more cards share the highest value all the cards in that round are thrown in the middle and the round started again, the player that wins the round gets all the cards in the middle too.

**Aim of the game** – to win all the cards by trumping the other players' stats!

### Dead man's fingers

Looks like a dead person's swollen fingers coming out of the ground, yuck!

### Death cap

### King Alfred's cakes

Can be used for lighting fires as it burns like charcoal

### Morel

Second only to truffles as a prized mushroom, very rare!

## Orange peel fungus

Looks like orange peel  
(but doesn't smell like it)

## Penny bun

Used in canned soups,  
also known as 'porcini'

## Pink waxcap

Usually found in grassy areas like grazed  
meadows and woodland glades

## Razorstrop fungus

Pieces of this fungus were carried by a  
5,300 year-old ice mummy found in the Alps

## Scarlet caterpillarclub

A parasitic fungus that lives  
on dead caterpillars

## Shaggy inkcap

This fungus has amazing strength - it can  
even push its way through tarmac

## Stinkhorn

Its spores are stored in a stinky slime that  
attracts flies which spread them

## Violet coral

Rare and beautiful, looks like it belongs  
under the sea with tropical fish :O)

## Yellow brain

Grows on dead branches where it looks  
like brains spilling everywhere
