Taylor Dent recorded the fastest ever serve at Wimbledon in 2010, whistling in at **148mph**. What is this in kilometres per hour? **236.8kph**

**£1.88 million** – that's the prize money collected by both the male and female singles Champion. What is this in standard form? **£1.88 × 10<sup>6</sup>**



The number of spectators who came through Wimbledon's doors in 2014 reached **491,084**. On average how many spectators go to Wimbledon each day, assuming that the tournament isn't extended due to inclement weather? **35,077**

It takes the court roof 10 minutes to close, how long is that in seconds? **600**

The roof covers 5,200 metres, what is that in inches? **204,724 inches**



**350,000** cups of tea are served during the Championships. spectators can purchase one of **230,000** glasses of Pimms.....**100,000** pints of beer or – if they're feeling flash – **28,000** bottles of champagne.

**28,000 kg** of strawberries and **7,000** litres of cream are guzzled during the two weeks. If a portion of strawberries and cream is 400g of strawberries, how many portions do they sell? **70,000**

Each glass of Pimms contains 300ml of liquid with the Pimms to lemonade ratio being 1:4. How many litres each of Pimms and lemonade are consumed?

**Pimms: 13800 litres**

**Lemonade: 55200 litres**



If 622 matches are played and 54,250 balls used in the tournament, on average how many balls are used each match? **87**

**54,250 balls** are used throughout the tournament, stored at a constant **20°C**. Convert this to Fahrenheit using the formula below:

$$(9/5)C + 32$$

**68°F**
