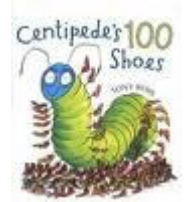



Centipede's 100 Shoes – Story Problems adapted Grades

<p>The centipede had 12 shoes. After he put his shoes in boxes, he has 6 left over. How many boxes does he have?</p> 	<p>The centipede took off 6 shoes before he took a break. He then took off some more shoes. He took off 10 shoes altogether. How many shoes did he take off after his break?</p> 
<p>The centipede had 9 shoes. Some should were too tight. 4 shoes were comfortable. How many shoes were too tight?</p> 	<p>The centipede polished 8 shoes before he took a break. He then polished some more shoes. He polished 16 shoes altogether. How many shoes did he polish after his break?</p> 
<p>The centipede had 14 shoes. He left some at school. He had 9 at home. How many shoes did he leave at school?</p> 	<p>The centipede put 12 shoes in a blue bag. He then put more shoes in a red bag. He bagged up 15 shoes altogether. How many shoes did he put in the red bag?</p> 
<p>The centipede had 12 shoes. After he put his shoes in boxes, he has 3 left over. How many boxes does he have?</p> 	<p>The centipede took off 7 shoes before he took a break. He then took off some more shoes. He took off 11 shoes altogether. How many shoes did he take off after his break?</p>
